
I am in receipt of your letter of the 18th instant in reference to the affairs of the Larne Shipbuilding Company.

I note that Messrs. John Kelly, Ltd., have offered to pay you the full fees and expenses due to the Society in the case of the s.s. "KERRYMORE" with the Builders' consent, but that the Engine Builders, Messrs. Campbell & Calderwood, of Paisley, have not paid the machinery survey fees.

It is observed, however, that the special survey request form in this case was signed on behalf of the Larne Shipbuilding Co., Ltd., and it would therefore appear that if the fees are paid in full on behalf of the Builders the matter will be in order.

I shall, however, be glad to hear from you further upon this subject before you take any action in the matter.
