Reverting to my letter to you of 10th inst regarding the Larne S.B. Co., I beg to inform you that this Company are to carry on their business for some time longer, if possible, with a view to getting at least one vessel No.80 launched.

John Kelly Ltd. have offered to pay to us the full fees and expenses on the S.S. "KERRYMORE", *with the builders' consent* provided we furnished them with the Classification Certificates, but, so far, the Engine builders, Campbell & Calderwood, Paisley, have not paid the machinery survey fees, and it appears to be doubtful whether they would part with the machinery certificate, until the Larne S.B. Co. has settled with them for the cost of the machinery.
