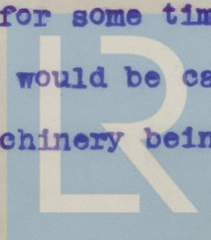

Sir,

Reverting to my letter to you of 10th inst. regarding the financial embarrasments of the two Shipbuilding Yards at Larne, I now beg to inform you that the Olderfleet S. & E. Co., Ltd. is in liquidation, and the concern is now advertised for sale.

The firms indebttness to the Society is as under, and I beg to be informed if it will be in order to submit to the official receiver Mr Hugh H. Smiley, Larne, our account for the travelling expenses, and a sum for part fee on the survey of their No.1 Dredger, (NELLIE).

So far, only one official visit has been paid to this vessel, for the examination of the sea-cocks, (apart from several conversations about the possibility of Classification), but we are informed that the survey of the machinery in Glasgow has been in progress for some time, and it was arranged that the hull survey would be carried out on a satisfactory report on the machinery being received.
