Dear Sirs,

With reference to the Refrigerating Fan Motors, Serial Nos. 5936.G, 5937.G, 5938.G and 5939.G now installed in the Motor Vessel "PACUAR" ex "Empire Aldo", I have to inform you that the Test Sheets for these machines have been examined and found satisfactory, but I am directed to call your attention to the fact that the Society's Rules for Refrigerating Machinery and Appliances of Ships require:-

- A) Air Stream motors intended for refrigerating fan purposes, irrespective of horse power, are to be built and tested under survey.
- B) Plans are to be submitted for approval, and the plans required are cross sectional views showing the construction, and in addition to showing the electrical details they should indicate clearly the type of bearings and arrangements for lubrication and terminals.

I shall accordingly be glad if you will kindly forward the necessary plans to this Office for approval in due course.
