instant in regard to the boiler test certificate number for  
"ISLANDER" and have looked into the case.

This vessel was fitted with watertube boilers  
component parts of which were tested at Messrs. Babcock &  
cox, Ltd's. Works. The boiler was then assembled and  
talled on board and was again tested as a complete unit.  
Unfortunately, the Surveyor who had this case in hand did not  
lise that a boiler test certificate should have been made out  
the number placed on the boiler and, therefore, there is  
certificate number in this case.

As each part of the boiler was stamped  
and tested, I think that in this case the matter might be allowed  
test where it is, but arrangements have been made in future  
a proper test certificate to be made out for all watertube  
ers when they are assembled and completed.
