The space between frames 41-53 is a dry compartment, with a
feed tank frames 53-62 having a length of 18'-0" and a S.W.
capacity of 32 tons.

The F.W. storage deep tank frames 106-109 has a length of 6'-0"
S.W. capacity of 29 tons.

The inside surfaces of the bottom of the vessel are coated with
wash.
