Dear Sir,

Reverting to your letters of the 13th instant with which the plans of Oertz Rudders proposed to be fitted in the vessels "NORD ATLANTIC" and "RIETPONTEIN" were returned to this Office I have to advise you that Messrs. Blohm & Voss, Hamburg, have taken up with this Office the question of the amendments which were made to the plans, and in this connection I am enclosing herewith a translation of Messrs. Blohm & Voss' letter in regard to the matter.

It will be seen from Messrs. Blohm & Voss' letter that the proposals submitted by them were based upon the scantlings and arrangements which were approved by the Committee in the case of the s.s. "ROEPAT" to which an Oertz Rudder was fitted by this firm in October, 1926. Owing to the short time which Messrs. Blohm & Voss had at their disposal to build and fit the reconstructed rudder in the case of these vessels the firm found it necessary to proceed with the work although a formal approval of the scantlings and arrangements had not been made. were received the s.s. "RIETFOONTEIN" had already been undocked and the rudder of the s.s. "NORD ATLANTIC" was completed and ready to be fitted in place. In the circumstances the alterations requested could not be carried out and Messrs. Blohm & Voss have requested that the cases of the rudders for these vessels might be given further consideration and the plans approved as submitted by them.
