Steamer "DEMOS" ex "TURKISTAN".

It is understood from the Society's Surveyors that you are now the Managers of this ship.

A General Examination of the vessel was carried out at London in December/January last with a view to a postponement of the Special Survey being granted. As a result of this inspection, the Committee have agreed to the Special Survey being postponed until October, 1962.

The class of the ship has been continued with fresh record of Drydocking Survey 12.61, subject to:-

1. Set in shell plates ninth from aft in the first and second below sheer (port side) and seventh from forward in the second and third below sheer (starboard side)

2. Indented shell plates F8 (port side forward) and F13 (starboard side forward) etc., also H17 and 19 and G16 (starboard side from aft)

all being specially examined and dealt with as necessary next drydocking.

In order to complete the Boiler Survey to enable a notation of 12.61 to be assigned, the safety valves of all boilers require to be adjusted, and I shall be glad to learn what arrangements are proposed in this respect.
