The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

("The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/62.)

A SPECIAL SURVEY (D) became due 5,59 and the ship was last examined in dry dock 10,59.

Notation "Surveys Overdue 5,59" was assigned.

ACTION was DEFERRED for Special Survey before re-commissioning.

Proposal for a voyage in tow as an unclassified ship to Rotterdam was approved 10.8.60 subject to a general examination being held.

The BRISTOL Surveyors report (8,60), this ship examined afloat and her condition found suitable for the proposed voyage.

In view of the above IT IS SUBMITTED the proposal to tow the vessel as an unclassified ship to Rotterdam merits approval, but ACTION continue to be DEFERRED for completion of Special Survey before re-commissioning and pending further information.
