We wish to bring to your attention the fact that the Survey for both Auxiliary Boilers of the above vessel was completed in June 1960 during drydocking at Falmouth. During the last drydocking at Rotterdam, January 1961, the Survey of the Starboard boiler was completed; therefore, this time the Port boiler is outstanding for Survey.

The vessel is an ore carrier and we find it extremely difficult, in view of the limited time she remains in Port, to carry out, this time, the Survey of the Port boiler.

It is our intention to drydock the vessel November/December 1961, and we would appreciate it if you would agree to the postponement of Port Boiler Survey until that time, when both boilers will be opened for the Annual Survey.

We hope the above proposal will receive your favourable consideration.
