M.S. "CORYDA"

I have your cablegram of today's date, and would inform you that if this ship is to proceed in tow from Singapore to Hong Kong, Japan or Taipei for breaking up, the Committee will be agreeable to you issuing a Certificate to cover the contemplated voyage after a satisfactory General Examination of the Hull has been carried out. This Certificate to be issued as for an Unclassed ship, and if steam is required during the tow, the Donkey Boiler Survey must be held before leaving Singapore.

If the ship is to proceed as a Classed ship, a General Examination of the Hull, Machinery and Electrical Installation will be required, together with the Donkey Boiler Survey, and the main engine attached bilge pump scrolls will require to be examined.
