Steamer "CAPTAIN COOK"

I have your letter of the 3rd February, and note that this ship is due at your port in about ten days time and after a week's stay will proceed to a U.K. anchorage and will be put up for sale.

As you are aware this ship is being surveyed on the "Progressive Survey" basis, and according to the Rule requirements the inspection should be completed by the end of this month, i.e. four years from the date of the last Special Survey. The Committee will, however, be agreeable to the ship retaining her class on the understanding that the outstanding items of this survey, the completion of the Boiler Survey and the outstanding conditions of class, will receive attention before the ship resumes service, and I shall be glad if you will advise the Owners accordingly.

I have to add that it is not considered desirable that we should comment on the manner in which the Owners intend to advertise the ship.
