Dear Sir,

S. Reverting to your letter of the 26th ultimo forwarding a report of survey held by a Surveyor appointed by you on the Trawler "KARLSEVNI", it would seem that this is an ex British Admiralty Corvette which was built under the Society's survey in 1941 for a special government class. As she seems to have been converted since that time and is also overdue for Special Survey, she has no class in the Society's Register Book.

Should the Owner desire classification it would be necessary in the first instance for plans to be submitted for approval during any alterations which have been or are intended to be made to the original construction, and also for her to be submitted to a Special Survey appropriate to her age.

Even if the alterations effected were found to be acceptable she could only be assigned a class for Fishing Purposes in association with a restricted draught, and I shall be glad if you will be good enough to confer with the Owner and let me know his wishes in the matter.
