

"KALSEVNI" ex FLOWER CLASS CORVETTE "LDSESTRIFE"

See Thorshavn letter 26.7.48

This vessel is stated to be now in use as a Trawler. Owing to deficiencies from the Rules these vessels cannot be given the 100A class as cargo vessels or trawlers, but have been given the class 100A with freeboard corresponding to a summer moulded draft of 14'-9" "For Whaling Services".

IT IS THEREFORE SUBMITTED the Owners be informed that if it is desired to retain the vessel in class, it will be necessary to submit her to a survey appropriate to her *in accordance with the Rules* age, and to submit for approval plans showing any alterations which have been or are intended to be made to the original construction. If these alterations are acceptable, then, on receipt of a satisfactory report the vessel could be recommended to the Committee for the class ~~A-~~ ⁺A- with freeboard corresponding to a summer moulded draft of 14'-9" "For Fishing Purposes".

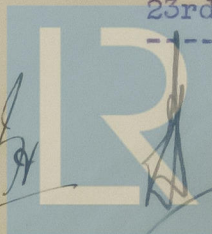
