The generator has been tested and the guaranteed requirements complied with. The working condition at the full and overload tests were found to be satisfactory, 2000 Volts insulation tests good.

The maximum temperature rise recorded after the full power test of the generator was not above 35° C.

For identification this generator has been stamped shopnumber 19706.
