We append hereto an extract of a letter received from Messrs. Wallen & Co., Ltd. which is self-explanatory.

"As you know, this vessel's special survey has been postponed by your Society until October this year. The vessel's present timecharterers have approached us with a request that they be allowed to retain the ship in her present service on the China Coast between Foochow and Shanghai for a further period of two months, as they have certain cargo commitments for that period.

In view of the fact that the ship's annual docking, loadline, boiler and part machinery and tailshaft surveys were completed in December 1957, we would appreciate it if you would kindly contact your Head Office and obtain their permission to extend the vessel's class for a further period of two months, up to the end of December 1958.

Looking forward to receiving a favourable reply, we remain."
