Dear Sir,

With reference to your First Entry Report No.1207, on the steel S.S. "DINOGA", I have to acquaint you that before this case receives the consideration of the Committee it will be necessary for you to state if the statutory tests of the Bower anchors and stream anchor were witnessed by one of the Society's Surveyors.

Information is also required as to whether the bulkhead stiffeners; thickness of inner bottom plating in Boiler space; diameter of rivets in keel butts; riveting in butts of side plating, bridge sheerstrake, upper deck stringer plate clear of bridge, and butts of inner bottom plating; and number of hawsers and warps, are all as approved.

In view of the fact that this vessel is built on the longitudinal system of framing, you should forward a supplementary report, giving all particulars as required for this type of vessel, and a supply of the necessary forms is forwarded herewith.
