The Society's Surveyors at London have reported that this ship was under survey in May/June when a General Examination was carried out in drydock with a view to a postponement of the Special Survey being granted.

In view of the satisfactory nature of the inspection carried out, the Committee have agreed to the Special Survey being postponed until July, 1961, and have continued the class of the ship with fresh record of Dry Docking 6.60 subject to:-

1. The main injection valve chest being renewed by the end of June, 1961.
2. The main overboard discharge chest being again examined and dealt with as necessary by the end of June, 1961.
