CLASS IS SUBJECT TO: the main high injection valve chest being renewed and the main overboard discharge valve chest being specially examined and dealt with as necessary at the next dry docking or by 9.60 (12 months limit).

General examination carried out at this time for proposed postponement of special survey according to Circular 1959 and found satisfactory.


SRL item, (1).

Replacement for the main injection valve chest not available at this time. The existing chest specially examined in way of wastage around inner periphery of cover joint and studs. At this time substantial strongback fitted across the cover of the chest and secured to side frames in way. Chest being considered efficient meantime but the Surveyor recommends that it be renewed before the end of June, 1961.

SRL item, (2).

Main overboard discharge chest specially examined and found to remain efficient, the Surveyor, however, recommends that this chest be again examined and dealt with as necessary by the end of June, 1961.

IT IS SUBMITTED that this vessel is eligible to remain as classed subject as now recommended.
