It is well that we refer to our Rtn.3 dated 24th April last, when we included the "COLONEL CROMPTON" which was under survey for condition.

We were called to this ship on account of small leakage in the bilge, but a considerable number of slack rivets were noted in frame feet connections, and question of repairs was referred to Owners for consideration. The vessel has since been lying in the River Wear, and we have now learned verbally that she has been sold for breaking up.

Since writing the above, it is noted from today's issue of Lloyd's List that the ship has been sold by the Central Electricity Authority to BISCO and, in these circumstances, it is not proposed to forward a report upon our uncompleted survey.
