John Dickinson & Sons Ltd., Sunderland.

The heater and valve chest, so far as could be ascertained, are sound and free from defects.

The tubes, headers and valve chest, were, in the presence of the undersigned, tested by hydraulic pressure to 500 lbs. per square inch, and the casing to 60 lbs. per square inch, with satisfactory results.
