the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of the Owners issue this report in order to state that the following damage repairs have been carried out on the Netherlands Steel Screw Motor Vessel "DUIVENDIJK" (ex. "CURACAO"), 8338 tons gross whilst placed in Wilton's drydock and lying afloat at Schiedam on the 3rd of June 1946 and subsequent dates.

- (1) Damage reported to have sustained through touching Alexandra Dock at Liverpool on the 15th April, 1942.

On starboard side:-

No. 4 plate in fourth strake below sheerstrake removed, faired and replaced.

3 shell frames faired in place.

4 shell lugs renewed.

Main deck stringer plate in way of above repairs cropped and partly renewed.

All broken and disturbed cement chocks renewed.

- (3) Through touching Muskisson Dock at Liverpool on the 29th April, 1942.

On Portside:- counted from aft

No. 2 plate in 2nd. strake below sheer strake faired in place.

One frame faired in place

One valve chest and pipe in way of repairs removed for access replaced in good condition

- (4) Through touching Brunswick Dock at Liverpool on the 30th April, 1942.

Starboard side in way of Engine room (counted from aft):-

No. 8 plate in 3rd strake below sheerstrake, faired in place.

2 frames faired in place, one beam knee renewed.

Repaired Work coated as required.
