Dear Mr. Zulver,

With regard to the case of the motor tanker "DRUPA" concerning which we did not receive the usual First Entry Report from our Hamburg Surveyors, you will doubtless be aware that the Committee recently agreed to assign a class, subject to the vessel being satisfactorily examined by the Society's Surveyors at Liverpool. This has now been done and a class of 100A1 "Carrying petroleum in bulk" has been assigned.

We have, however, no record in this Office as to whether the fees have been paid in this case, and I shall be glad if you will kindly let me know if you have any knowledge of the Builders having paid these fees to our Surveyors at Hamburg prior to the outbreak of war.
