Motorship "CALPEAN STAR"

I acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 19th instant and, in reply to the two points raised by you, I would say:-

1. Where a casualty may affect maintenance of class it is the responsibility of the shipowners to have a survey carried out under the supervision of the Society's Surveyors.
2. If the grounding under review had been reported and the ship from an examination and/or soundings afloat had given no indication of damage from this cause the Committee would not necessarily have required the General Examination for postponement to include drydocking before granting postponement of the Special Survey.
