

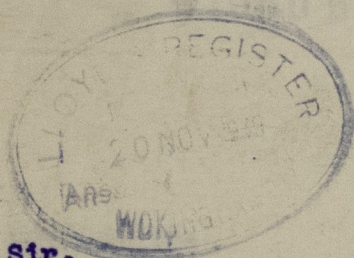

M.V. "DONACILLA", Greenock Report No. 20841.

In reply to your letter of the 10th instant regarding the above; the Engine Builders confirm that the maximum power of this engine is 3600 B.H.P. at 120 r.p.m., the normal power is 3000 B.H.P. at 114 r.p.m., also the bilge pump capacity according to the plan for this vessel is 32 tons per hour.

With regard to the spare gear a complete list in book form was enclosed with the plans.

Grimsby Report No. 21030 on the Compressor fitted is returned herewith. The other report was inadvertently enclosed with the first entry reports.
