Ltd., attend on board the motor tanker "DONACILLA", 8113 tons gross of LONDON as she lay afloat at Singapore on 10th March 1961 for the purpose of examining the weather decks with their openings and closing appliances etc., to certify the tanker to be in a fit condition to be towed from Singapore to HONG KONG for breaking up purposes.

The closing appliances to all hatchways, openings in decks and superstructure bulkheads, casing etc., skylights ventilators and airpipes found satisfactory. Deadlights closed on all sidelights.

The rudder tiller efficiently lashed in midship position and spurling pipes fitted with cement boxes.

All sea valves, cargo tank line valves and tank gas line valves permanently closed.
