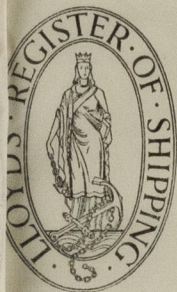

and that I will transmit to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London, a Report, stating that all ^{Temporary} repairs recommended by me have been completed to my satisfaction, also that I will recommend that she be continued as classed without fresh record of S.S. subject to the starboard hawsepipe being renewed at the next Special Survey, and as previously recommended, to shell plates C.14 D.14 & D.12 from aft (ps) and H.3 (p & s) being specially examined and dealt with as necessary at the next Special Survey.
