Dear Sirs,

E. I am in receipt of your letter of the 27th ultimo respecting the s.s. "MAURITZ" and have to say it is noted that the Society's Surveyor at Helsingborg has surveyed the main boilers of this vessel and made a special examination of the circumferential seams with entirely satisfactory results, no signs of leakage or strain being observed.

With regard thereto I have to inform you that, since in other respects the scantlings of the boilers as shown on the plan are considered satisfactory for the desired working pressure of 180 lb. per sq. inch, the boilers could be accepted for this working pressure, provided that on completion of the examination the boilers be found to be in good condition and the scantlings in accordance with the plan. The plan is returned herewith.
