Transversely Framed Tanker "GARD"

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letters of the 24th and 27th instant respecting this ship, and note the amicable discussion which you have had with the Owners on this case.

Their request that a further postponement of the stiffening might be acceded to provided a favourable report is received at the drydocking to be carried out in early May next, has received consideration, but in view of their experience with this type of ship, the Committee do not feel that they can justifiably depart from their previous decision, and I shall be glad if you will inform the Owners that irrespective of the state of the structure as revealed at the forthcoming drydocking, it will be necessary for deck girders to be fitted before the end of September next, as previously recommended.
