I gather from your letter that you did not receive mine of the 8th January last enclosing a copy of one received from Mr. Dobson while he was in San Francisco in reply to your earlier classing letter.

I am therefore forwarding a further copy of Mr. Dobson's letter herewith, and if this is not sufficient to let you complete the case I would suggest that the vessel's class be made subject to the equipment of chain cables being ranged, examined and dealt with as found necessary at the next drydocking.
