Convention Freeboard.

The following work is now in hand consequent on obtaining Convention Freeboard Assignment.

- (1) Steel cover to hatchway on forecandlehead in lieu of wood.
- (2) Turn buckles to three steel doors upper end of fore-castle manipulated from both sides.
- (3) Steel plate door in lieu of wood door to lower fore-castle starboard.
- (4) Forward cargo hatch cover of steel in lieu of wood as per plan herewith.
- (5) Pump room hatchway cover of steel.
- (6) Bulwarks, alterations as per plan herewith.
- (7) Hinged steel deadlights to upper bridge skylight P & S.
- (8) Steel W.T door in lieu of wood door to after end of Engineer deckhouse.
- (9) Solid teak door to upper bridge front & after end in lieu of panelled door.
- (10) Solid teak door to boatswain's room.
- (11) Hardwood doors from upper bridge front transferred to seamens forecandle P & S.
