Dear Sir,

With reference to Wokingham letter "S" dated 31st. July, 1941, regarding Liverpool First Entry Report No. 116258, I have to state that the length of the bridge has been modified to suit Admiralty requirements as regards deck stowage, details of which were given in the Freeboard Report for the same vessel. In accordance with Circular No. 1551, the length of the forecastle is 50 ft. The thickness of the inner side girders in the double bottom tank under the engines was incorrectly transcribed, and should be .60".

The name of the sister vessel was shown in the General Declaration on page 3 instead of the General Remarks on page 4.
