Enclosed please find a copy of a letter we have today received from Messrs. Cosens & Co. Ltd, Weymouth, regarding the fee we charged for survey carried out to allow this vessel to proceed in tow to Belgium. Please see Secretary's letter Classn.(S) dated 17th December, 1959, and also Southampton certificate dated 19th December, 1959, on this ship.

As the survey we carried out was in excess of the requirements of an Annual Load Line Survey, we based our fee on the Load Line Scale of Fees (1958 No. 2271 for an Annual Survey on an unclassified ship, i.e. £25.0.0. plus travelling expenses £5.0.0.

The survey was carried out at Portland Harbour and took a complete day.
