Steamer "EAGLESDALE"

This ship was under survey at Newport, Monmouthshire, in April/June when the Special Survey of the hull was carried out in drydock, the Engine Survey completed and the Boiler Survey held.

A record of drydocking 6,58 and notations of S.S. Newport 6,58, Engine Survey 6,58 and Boiler Survey 6,58 have been assigned. Classification Certificates in respect of the Special Survey of hull and machinery are enclosed.

The suffix "Dr" indicating that the shell and deckplating has been satisfactorily drill tested, and any renewals or repairs found necessary carried out, has been withheld at this time in view of the fact that a worn deck plate in 'C' strake, port side, in way of No.1 cargo tank has not been dealt with. When this plate has received attention, the appropriate drilling notation will be inserted in the Society's Register Book.
