With regard to the matters discussed at your visit yesterday, I presume you received the copy of the special report issued by the Hamburg Surveyors in December last on the steamer "EMPIRECCARRON". This was sent round to your Office yesterday afternoon.

I have also to confirm that I cabled the Hamburg Surveyors to see what could be done to expedite classification with us. At the same time I have seen our Plans people regarding the "PENNSYLVANIA" and from all accounts it appears that she is one of the "Hamilton" type of two-deck standard ship built by the Americans in the first world war.

As I told you yesterday we have standard plans of this type which were duly approved as conforming to our Rules, so that so far as scantlings are concerned all that would be necessary would be for our Surveyors to be given the opportunity of checking her with those plans. There would naturally be the appropriate survey but I know you are prepared to undergo this.
