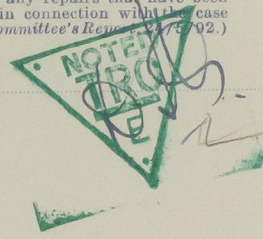

This T.2 tanker was built in May, 1945 to American Bureau requirements, and classification with this Society is now desired.

First Entry Reports on the Electrical Propulsion Gear and Electrical Equipment have been examined, and the details are similar to previous vessels of this type which have already been accepted.

A General Examination of the Machinery has been held in dry dock, and the Classification Survey of the Machinery commenced.

A Boiler Survey was last held in 5.47, by American Bureau Surveyors.

The Screwshaft has not been examined since the vessel was built.

IT IS SUBMITTED this vessel's machinery is eligible for the notation "Examined 11.47 (Class contemplated)"
