efficient, and safe working condition, at a pressure of 85 lb
per square inch on the main boilers. The approved working pressure
of the donkey boiler is 8 lb. per square inch.

FITTLE FOR OIL FUEL 10,47, FLASH POINT ABOVE 100°F
(Lloyd's Machinery Certificate) has been made in the Register

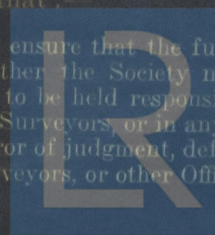
