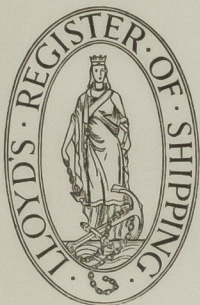

 Recommend that she be eligible to remain as now classed,
 without fresh record of Survey, and without conditions of Class
 regarding Anchor Chain Cables, but subject to all other
 conditions of Class being dealt with as previously recommended.
