With reference to Glasgow First Entry Report No. 38834 being forwarded to-day on the Steamer "ARDGANTOCK", I beg to acquaint you that the state of progress of this vessel when taken over from the Admiralty was Hull three-fifths completed, Machinery three-fourths.

As according to the procedure laid down it would appear that the fee charged for the survey of the Hull, Machinery and Boilers of this vessel according to the Society's Rules is in excess of what it would have been charged under the special arrangement for Standard Vessels, it is concluded that no special charge will be made to the Admiralty in respect of the work carried out under their instructions.
