## SOURCE OF INFORMATION

TARAPACA. — Valparaiso, July 28. — Chilean motor vessel Tarapaca, owned by Corporacion de Fomento de la Produccion Chile and operated by Martinez, Pereira y Cia., S.A. Naviera, went aground on some rocks near the inlet and small port of Bahia Mansa. The vessel had broken in two by No. 1 hold and is considered to be totally lost. — New York Maritime Association.

TARAPACA. — London, Aug. 5. — Lloyd's Agent at Valdivia reported in London to-day that he had received the following message from Valdivia: Chilean motor vessel Tarapaca sank Bahia Mansa rocks on July 26 due to gale. Breakage of rudder made escape impossible. Now forepart separated at No. 3 hold (before reported No. 1 hold). (See issues of Aug. 4 and 5.)
