Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines in

D.E.M.S. accommodation at port after end of bridge tween decks dispensed with.
Tonnage opening in bridge end (p.s.) reinstated with portable steel plate secured with hooked bolts spaced 12" apart as temporary closing appliance.
Hinged steel W.T. door 4' 6" x 24" operated from both sides fitted in portable plate.
Companionway & 2 - 10" diameter vents removed from bridge deck and 1 overboard discharge and 2 portlights removed, all openings efficiently plated over.
