I have compared the arrangements on board the ship with those given in the original freeboard report and I have found them to be in agreement therewith or equivalent thereto, and the whole to be in efficient condition.

Vessel examined afloat, for purpose of extending the present freeboard Certificate until 31st January, 1947, to enable vessel to return to Rotterdam for refit.
