Dear Sir,

With reference to the freeboard under the new Convention in the case of the M.V. "KOTA INTEN" I beg to inform you that it appears that this vessel has an accommodation for more than 12 passengers and in connection therewith the Dutch Freeboard Commission informs us that no reduction in freeboard for such vessel will be allowed under the new Convention 1930.

She is generally used and can be looked upon as a cargo vessel, but holds a certificate whereby she is allowed to carry more than 12 cabin passengers.

It may be well to note this is the case with all Kota vessels of the Rotterdamsche Lloyd and the Poelau vessels of the Compagnie van de Koninklijke Lloyd van Rotterdam. "NEDERLAND".
