With reference to the Special Survey which became due in November last, we have to inform you that, since the preparatory examination held on the 1st May of this year, nothing further has been done towards the survey as all work has been suspended and we have not yet been acquainted with the Owners' intentions.

This ship is still laid up at Peterhead and the Owners have been advised that the Main Boiler Survey became due last month, the Screwshaft Survey becomes due this month and that the ship has not been surveyed in drydock since September 1956. A reply has been received stating that no action is being taken meantime.
