and that I am transmitting to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London, a report, stating that ~~all repairs recommended by me have been completed to my satisfaction, also that~~ I am recommending that she be eligible to remain as classed without fresh record of drydocking, and subject to permanent repairs being effected to the sternframe, shellplating, etc., before the vessel leaves this Port.
