A.S.B. "River" Class Vessels.

Reverting to your letter of the 5th September, 1942 and your Special Survey authorisation dated 8th September of that year, you will note that the original order from the Australian Shipbuilding Board was for eleven "A" or "River" Class vessels.

This programme was increased to thirteen by placing orders for two additional vessels at Evans Deakin's Yard, Brisbane.

The A.S.B. sent in a request for Survey of these vessels in December last, but to keep the matter in line with requirements, I am now forwarding (Req. 1a) in respect of these vessels now under construction at Brisbane.

Req. 9 was also signed by the A.S.B. in respect to the Freeboard Survey of these vessels and these Forms will be forwarded with our Freeboard Reports.
