Dear Sir,

With reference to Brisbane F. E. Report No. 4970 on the Refrigerating Appliances of the steamer "RIVER NORMAN," I am informed by The Australian Shipbuilding Board that the two Halls C.02 machines were supplied to their order No. M.M. 1536 and specified to conform with the Society's requirements for a classed installation. They were shipped in July, 1945 by the S.S. "Empire Rawlinson" and consigned direct to Brisbane.

The serial numbers of these sets were No. 11862 for compressor and No. 22948 for Steam Engine; the second set - No. 11863 for compressor and 22947 for the Steam Engine.

Under cover of your letter "H" of the 8th June, 1945, you forwarded photostat copy of London Report No. 1431 on the refrigerating machinery Nos. 11845/6 supplied to a sister vessel "River Mitta" at Melbourne but we do not appear to have had any report, nor can the A.S.B. supply us with any Certificate for installation now supplied to "River Norman."

It would appear from the above that you will have records in your office regarding the survey of this machinery.
