
This is to Certify that this Ship has been built under the Special Survey of the Surveyors to this Society, and was reported to be, on the 2nd January, 1953 in a fit and efficient condition as is prescribed by the Society's Rules for the safe carriage of dry and perishable or other approved Cargoes, and has been CLASSED and entered in the REGISTER BOOK of this Society, with the Character **100A1** Carrying oil Flash Point above 150°F or vegetable oil in midship tanks

subject to Periodical Surveys as required by the Rules.
Electrically welded except side shell seams and frames.

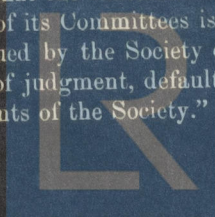
