With reference to your  
Return 3 dated the 25th January,  
I concluded that the Auxiliary  
Engine Survey which became due  
at the end of January, is being  
carried out at this time, but your  
confirmation will be appreciated.

Date:— Bombay, 29th March, 1963.

The ship is lying in  
Bombay Harbour having sustained  
serious fire damage in the  
engine room. She has been sold  
for scrap subject to permission  
from the Government of India  
which is expected to be granted  
within the next month.

Our Return 3 of 25th  
January referred to a survey as  
to the ship's fitness to lie as  
a hulk in Bombay.
