Pump No. 51914 having 3" suction and 2½" delivery branches delivered 10.9 tons per hour of oil against a total head of 25 lbs. per sq. inch when running at 1635 revs. per minute.

The pump casing had been tested by hydraulic pressure to 450 lbs. per sq. inch, and for identification the pump has been stamped:-
